ABSTRACT FORMAT

Abstracts should have the following structure: Title of the abstract, authors’ names and Institutional affiliations (list multiple affiliations one below the other) and mark each with a superscript “1” “2”. Provide Background, Objective, Methods, Findings and Conclusion. Mark the name of the corresponding author with an asterisk (*). Provide Email address of the corresponding author. An abstract must not exceed 300 words using Times New Roman 12. Abstract form template is also available online at www.nimr.or.tz
